Dense sheet or broad band of irregular connective tissue that lines the body wall and limbs and surrounds muscles and other organs of the body. Holds muscles with similar functions together, allows free movement of muscles, carries nerves, blood vessels, and lymphatic vessels; and fills spaces between muscles.

Skeletal muscles are striated and most are attached to bones by tendons. They are typically named because of their location, function, shape, or origin. For example, the trapezius muscle in the back is named because of its trapezium, or diamond, shape. However, the transverse abdominis is so named because of its location in the abdomen.
